



## Energy Procurement Offer

Saveawatt is offering to complete an in depth analysis and modelling of your current energy supply agreements and manage your Energy Requests for Proposal (RFP) to ensure your business is not paying more for its energy that it needs to. All work is undertaken on a no savings, no fee **performance-related** basis.

- 1) Authorise and return our Energy Customer Authority (see page 2) and Energy Procurement Agreement (see page 3) to us. By doing this, you authorize Saveawatt to negotiate with the applicable energy retailers and hence confirm that you have accepted the terms and conditions of this offer.
- 2) Provide us with a full copy, all pages both sides, of a recent full set of monthly electricity account(s).

If we negotiate lower quoted prices for supply to your business, our performance-related fee is **20 % of the projected cost savings over the contract term**. We will obtain a quotation reflecting savings via a reputable energy retailer (i.e. from Contact, Energy OnLine, Genesis, KCE, Mercury, Prime, Meridian, Nova, TrustPower, etc).

### Just follow two simple steps to cut your electricity costs:

1. Fill out the enclosed Customer Authorisation Form (see page 2) & Procurement Agreement (see page 3) and sign/return them to us.
2. Provide us with a full copy (all pages both sides) of a recent full set (all accounts) of monthly electricity account(s).

This form authorises Save A Watt Ltd to negotiate Energy Supply Agreements on our behalf with all energy retailers in New Zealand. As such, we appoint Saveawatt as our exclusive energy consultant / broker for the purposes of managing one off Energy Requests for Proposal (RFP).

Saveawatt and its agents are hereby authorised to request the applicable data from our existing energy retailer(s) including but not limited to the existing contract expiry date(s), detailed TOU usage data (kWh), NHH usage data (kWh), demand data (kVA and KW), reactive load data (kVAr and PF), customer transaction summaries, ICP numbers, invoices, meter details, existing prices/detailed price breakdown, local network charges and any other aspects of our energy account

This Authorisation Form will automatically cease to apply within 90 days of the closing date of the Energy RFP's issued by Saveawatt. It is acknowledged that all information presented both by and to Saveawatt is to be kept in strict confidence by both parties.

It is also acknowledged that this Authorisation Form is intended to comply with the requirements of the Privacy Act.

## Procurement Agreement

The performance-related fee is equivalent to **20%** of the calculated cost savings obtained during the new contract term. If there is no savings obtained over the term of the contract there is no fee payable irrespective of the work undertaken.

The fee is payable in full to Saveawatt by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month of invoice issue unless alternate arrangements are made in writing prior to the signing of this agreement. The fee is based on the best quoted energy rates received by Saveawatt and collection fees and penalties may be incurred for late payments to us. In some cases Saveawatt may receive an administration fee from the energy retailer. On receipt of any fee under this agreement the Brewers Guild of New Zealand will be entitled to a commission from Saveawatt.

In signing this agreement we understand that Saveawatt will complete an analysis of our energy procurement and negotiate on our behalf to achieve cost savings via a major energy retailer. In acknowledgement of this work undertaken we agree we are liable for the fee (as per above) if for any reason we decline to take up their recommended offer(s).

Savings are calculated using our historical energy volume and the difference between the benchmark price and the new energy price negotiated by Saveawatt over the term of the contract obtained:

- The energy volume used for fee calculation will be our actual monthly kWh usage during the past 12 months unless we advise Saveawatt to the contrary in writing prior to signing this agreement.
- The benchmark energy price used for the Saveawatt fee calculation will be the proposed new contract energy prices quoted to Saveawatt by our existing **contracted** energy retailer. Alternatively, if we are currently being supplied on an **uncontracted** basis our current energy prices will provide the benchmark energy price. Should our existing contracted energy retailer quote the best prices our fee will be based on any savings versus their current energy prices.

By authorising this agreement, we confirm that we fully understand and accept the stated terms and conditions of this agreement.
